

MATRIC RESULTS 2011 – 5th January 2012

Dear Parents

Yes it is that time of the year again when we sit and do an analysis on how our final year group have done. This year we can be truly proud of our 68 Matriculants all of whom have passed! Not only have they all passed but they once again have given us a very good exemption rate; 59 (87%) have qualified to go to University. This remains a very good record.

12 others managed 1 distinction.

This means that 68 pupils got 143 distinctions this is more than 2 each, this ratio is very good! In addition 36 distinctions were over 90%. Sadly 15 subjects were given as 79% however some of these marks may improve once remarks are done!!

On a subject basis - with the number of distinctions in brackets and the subject average:

Science (19) – 72%; Maths (15) – 62% + Maths Literacy (1) – 68%+ Maths Paper 3 (8) – 77% +Advanced Maths (1) – (62%); Life Science (9) – 70%; Information Technology (4) – 74%, Life Orientation (21) – 72%;

Accounting (16) 79%; Business Studies (8) – 69%; History (11) – 81%; Geography (5) – 67%, Hospitality Studies 66%, English (11) – 70%; Afrikaans (13) 66%; Sepedi 65%; French (1) 75%

These results are by far the best that the College has ever managed to achieve, well done to all concerned – the pupils who worked for these results and to the teachers who managed to get the best out of these pupils and lastly to the parents who made it all possible. Well done!!

To those returning, the bar has well and truly been raised, we now have to live up to this standard. See you all back at the College on Thursday 12th January.
